CORRESPONDENCE -

HEALTH DEPARTMENT CONTRACT – The Commission received the annual Contract with the Marshall County Health Department for its' contribution in the amount of \$120,000 (plus the cost of dental, vision, and life insurance), payable in quarterly allotments.

On motion of Commissioner Gruzinskas, seconded by Commissioner Miller, the Commission approved the annual Contract, in the amount of \$120,000 (plus the cost of dental, vision, life insurance), payable quarterly, and the President was authorized to sign the same. Motion carried.

CAMERON AGRICULTURAL TEAM – John Lockhart and Jenny Stoneking, Cameron teachers, appeared before the Commission. Students Breana Boggs, Carlee Francis, Levi Scott, and Raegan Whipkey presented Marcellus Shale Natural Gas Production in West Virginia. The students discussed Marcellus shale, impacts drilling has on the economy, showed various well pads and pipelines, and discussed production over the past three years.
